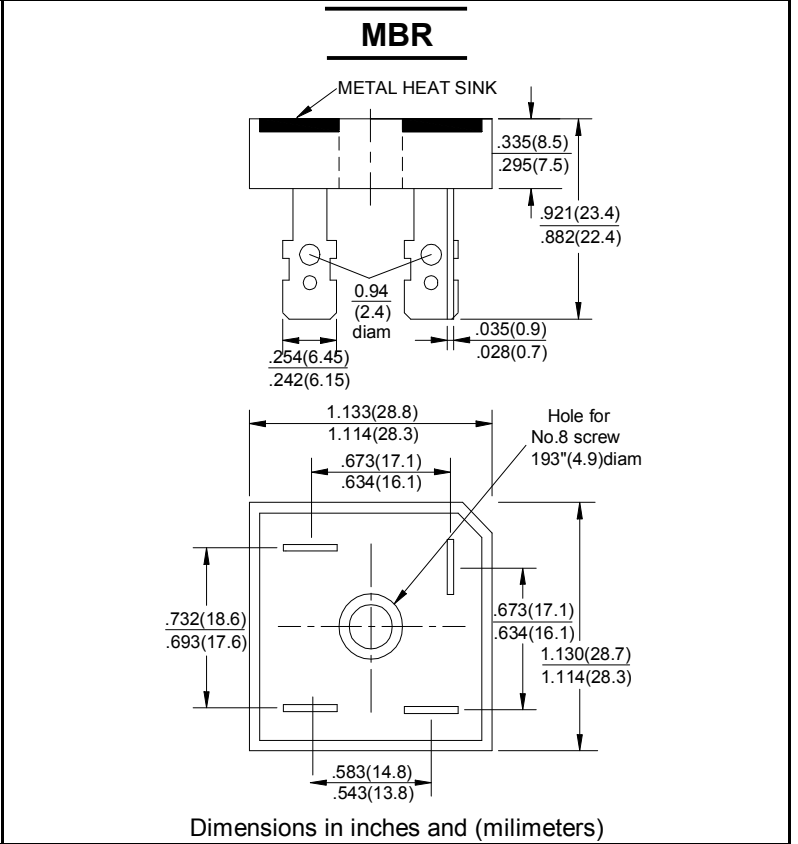

FIG.1-MAXIMUM FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

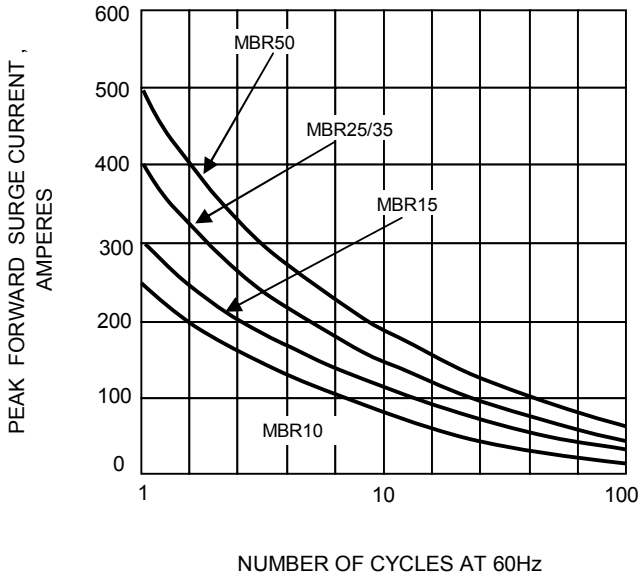


FIG.2- DERATING CURVE  
OUTPUT RECTIFIED CURRENT

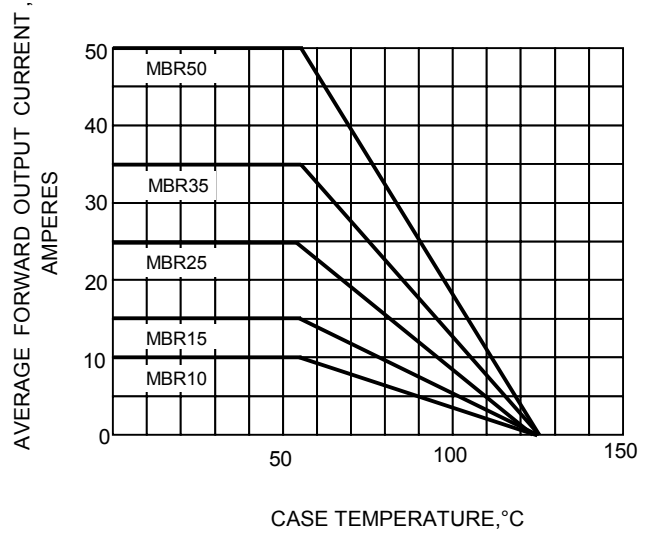


FIG.4-TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

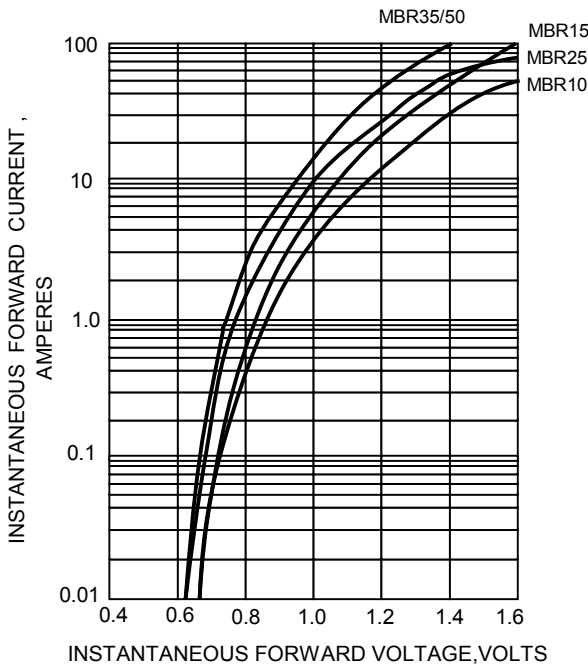


FIG.5-TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS
