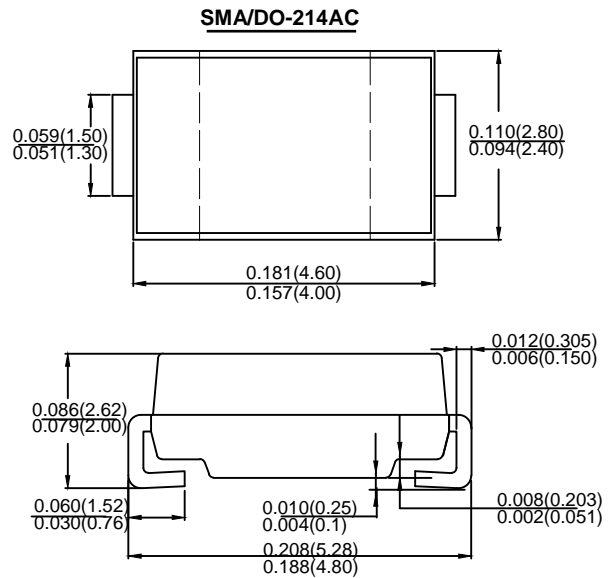

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Fig. 1 Forward Current Derating Curve

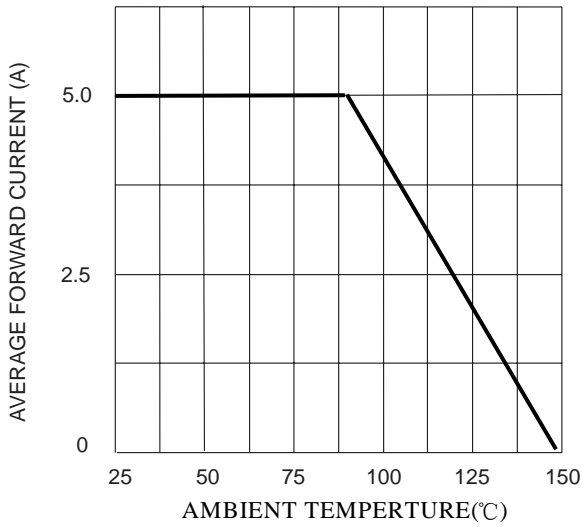


Fig. 2 Typ. Forward Characteristics

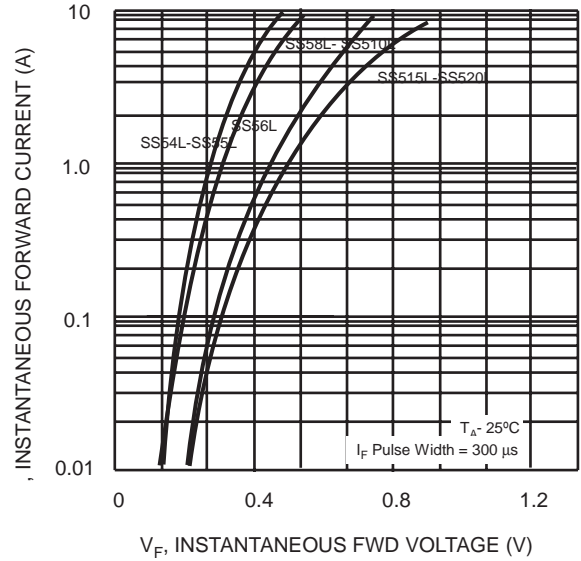


Fig. 3 Max Non-Repetitive Peak Fwd Surge Current

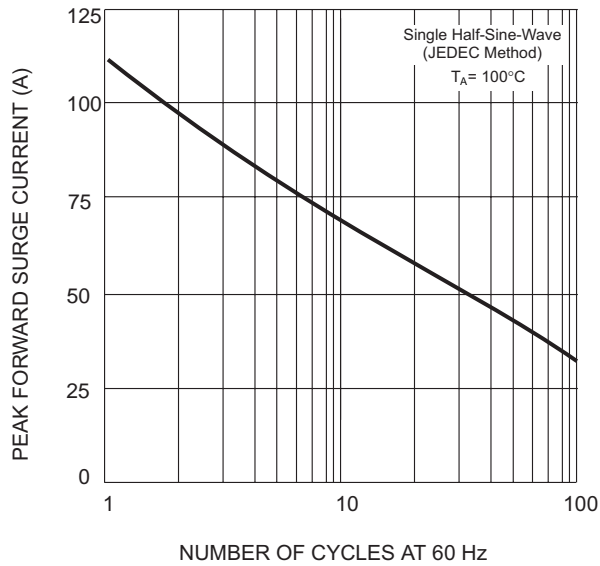


Fig. 4 T<sub>r</sub> typical Reverse Characteristics (per element)
