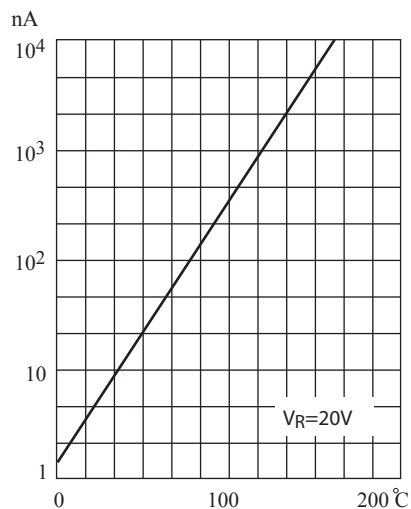

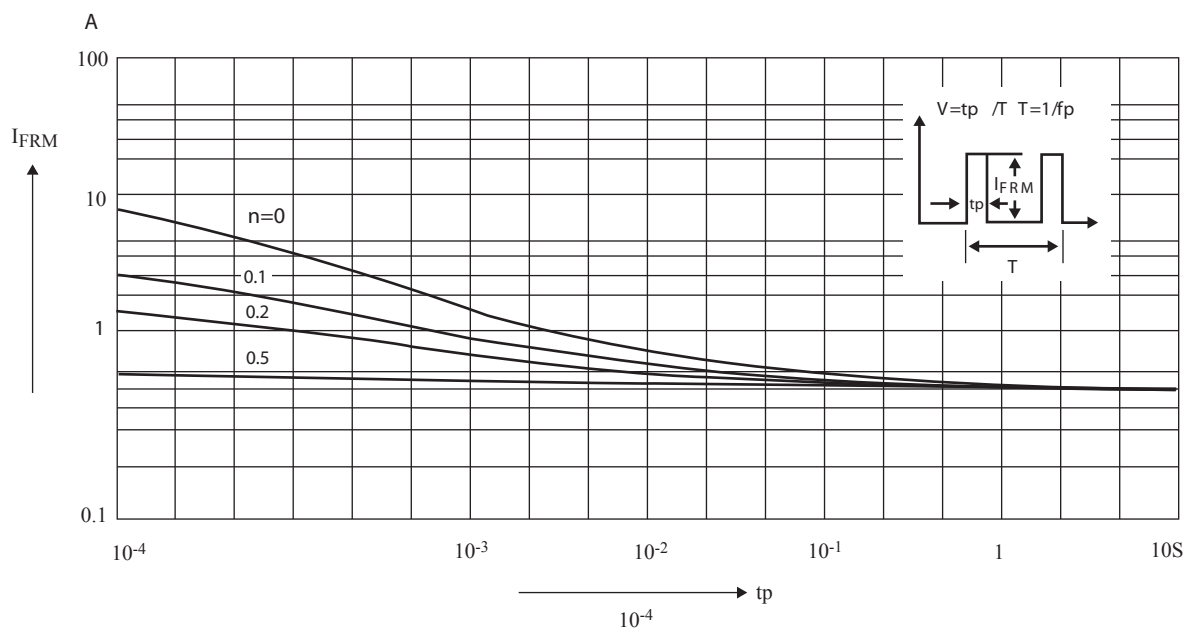

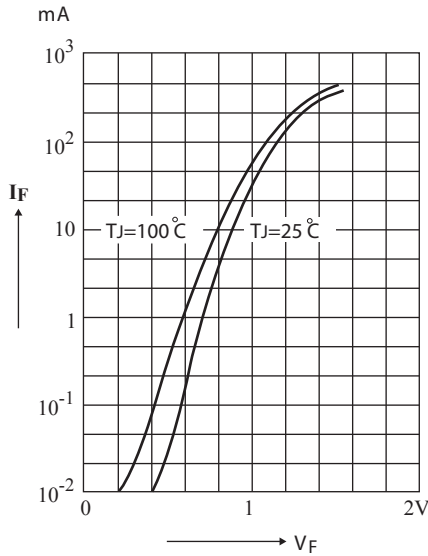
**RECTIFICATION EFFICIENCY MEASUREMENT CIRCUIT**



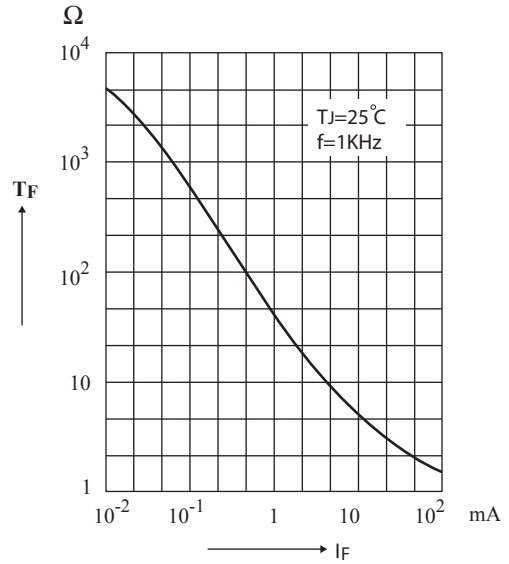
**FIG 1, LEAKAGE CURRENT VERSUS JUNCTION TEMPERATURE**



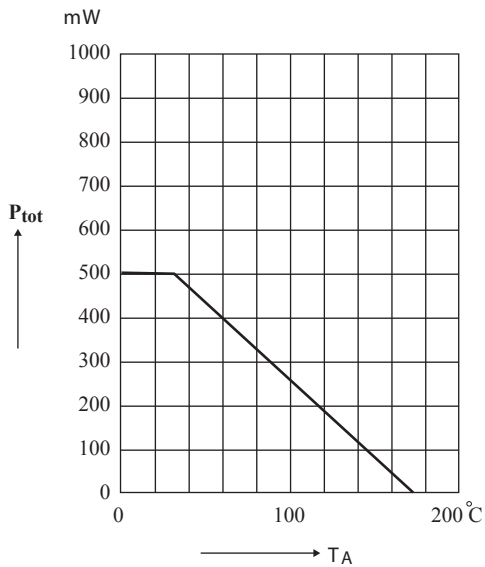
**FIG 2, ADMISSIBLE REPETITIVE PEAK FORWARD CURRENT VERSUS PULSE DURATION**



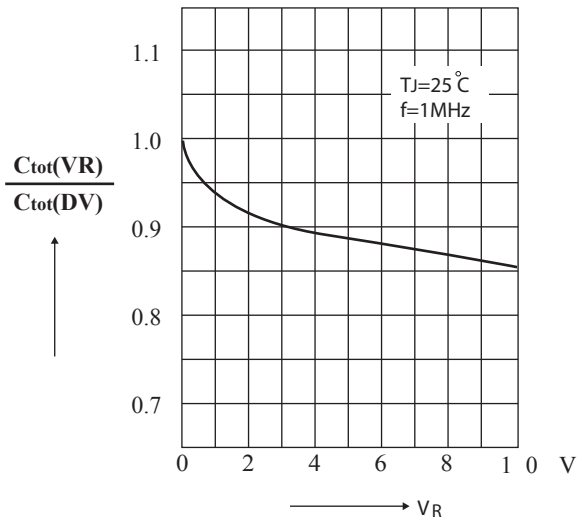
**FIG 3, FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS**
