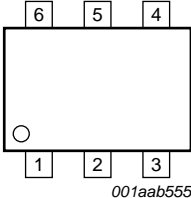
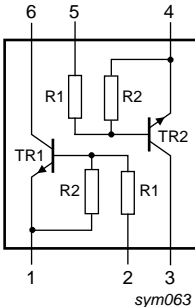

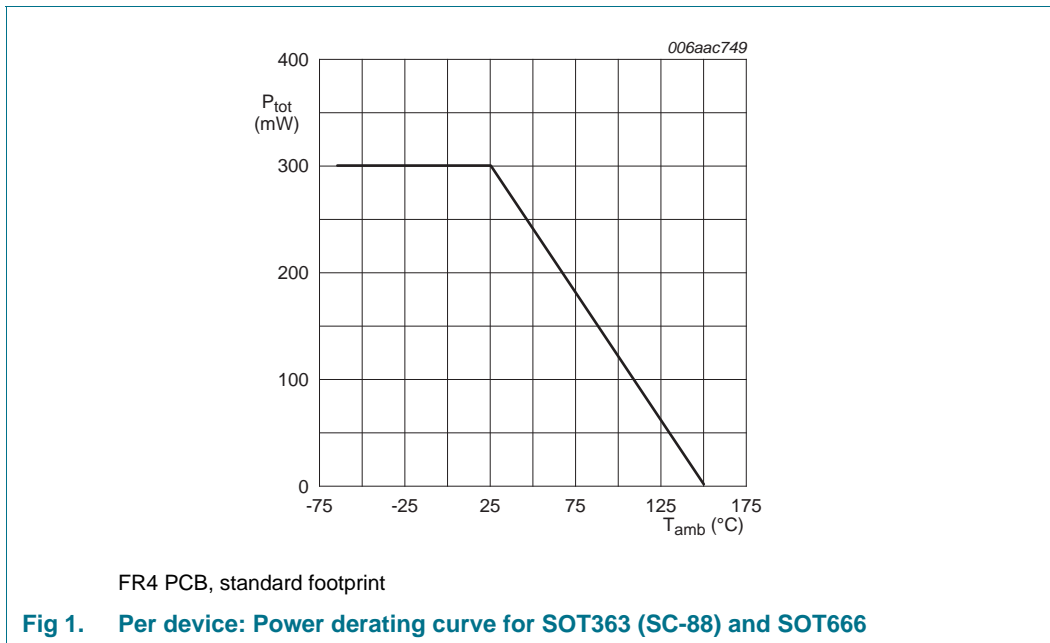

**Fig 3. Per transistor: Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration for PUMH15 (SOT363); typical values**

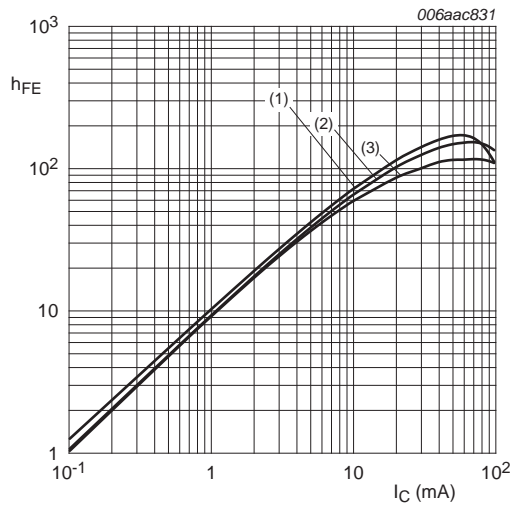

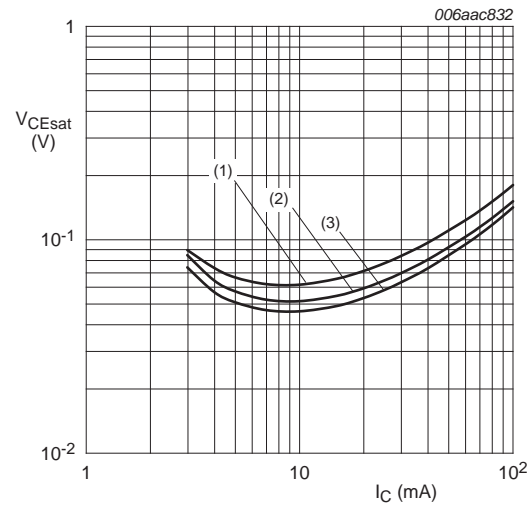

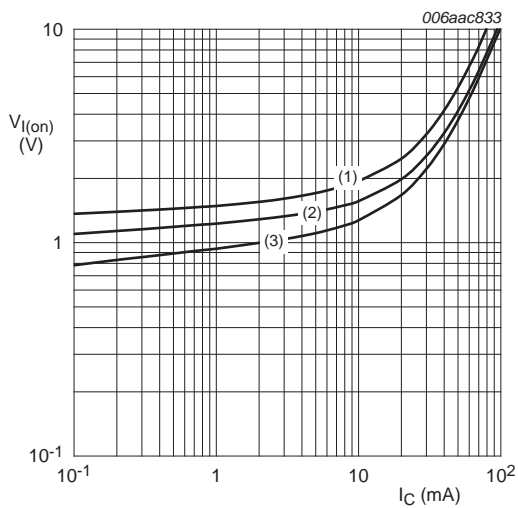

**Fig 4. DC current gain as a function of collector current; typical values**



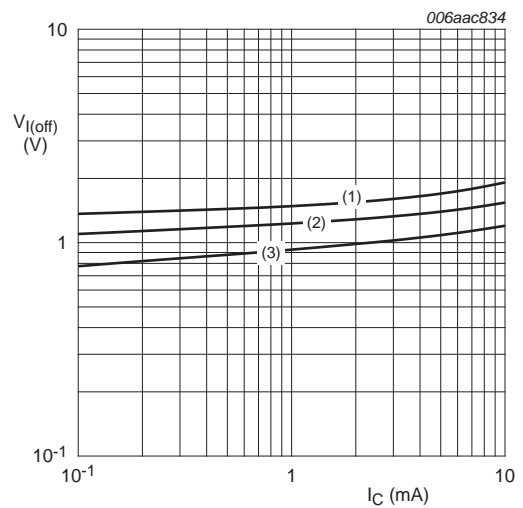

**Fig 5. Collector-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values**



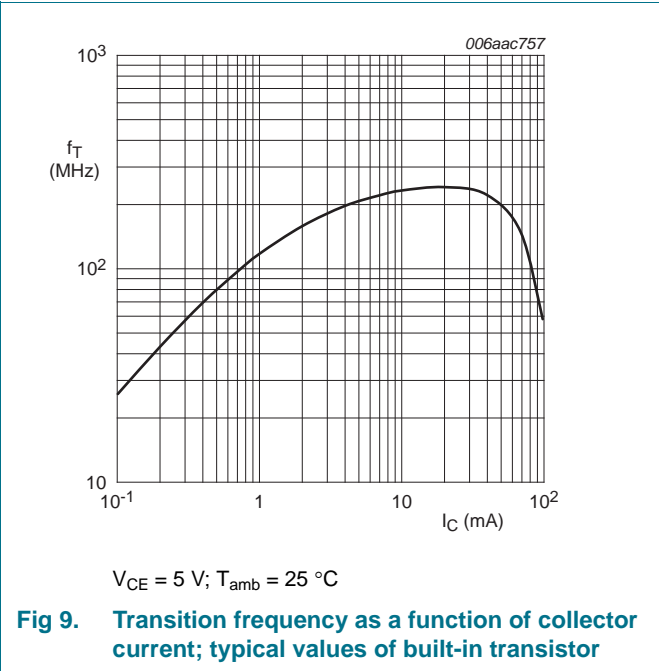
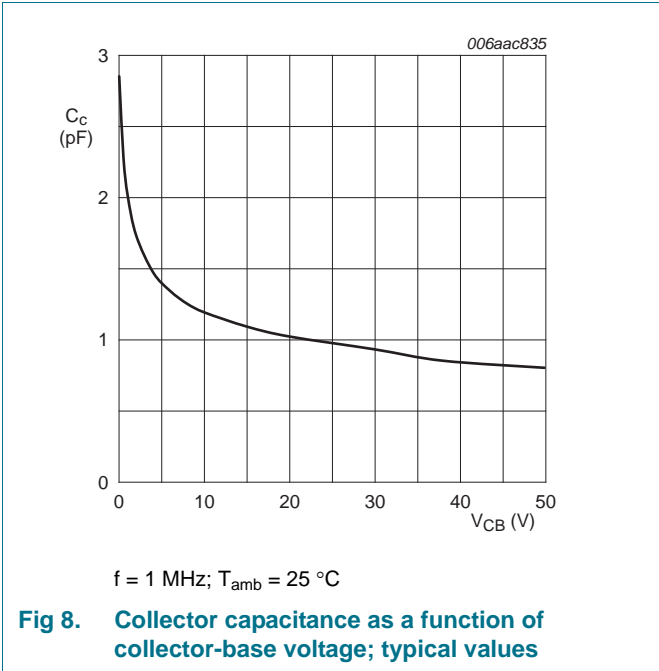

**Fig 7. Off-state input voltage as a function of collector current; typical values**

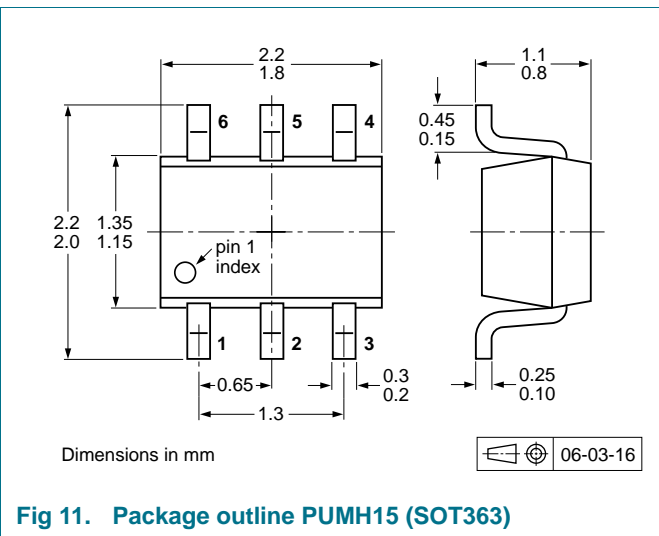
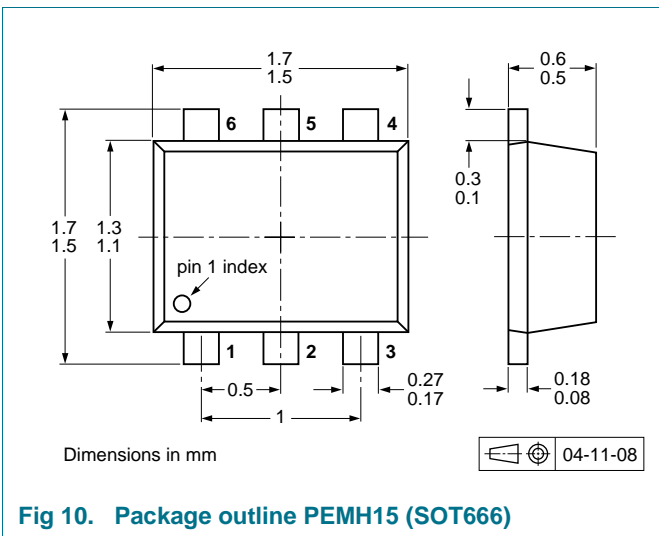

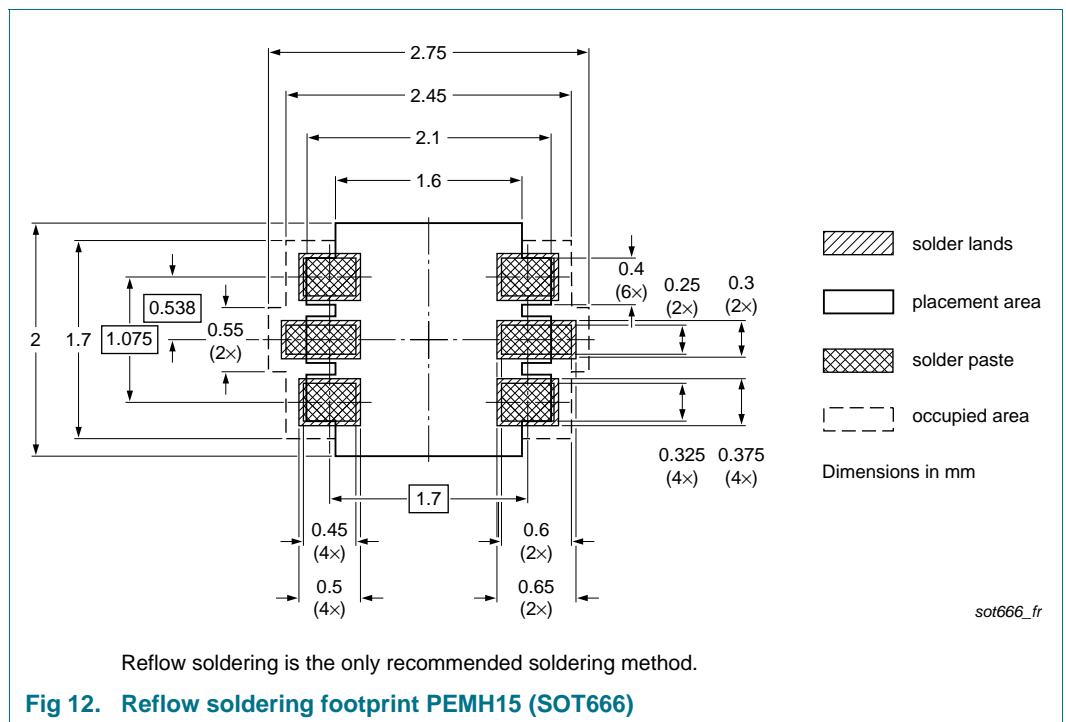




Fig 13. Reflow soldering footprint PUMH15 (SOT363)

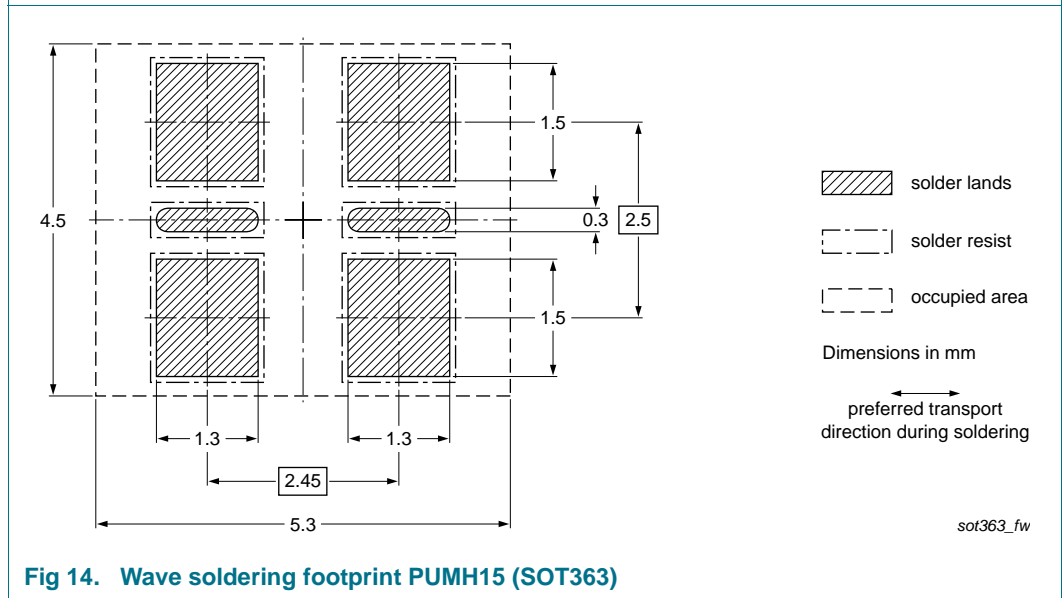


Fig 14. Wave soldering footprint PUMH15 (SOT363)
