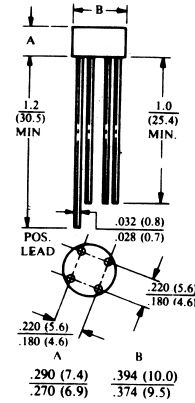

OUTPUT RECTIFIED CURRENT

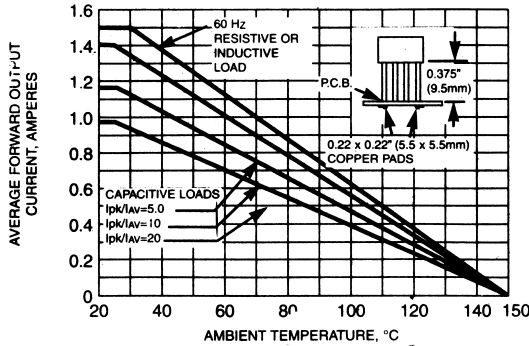


FIG.2-MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE PEAK

FORWARD SURGE CURRENT PER LEG

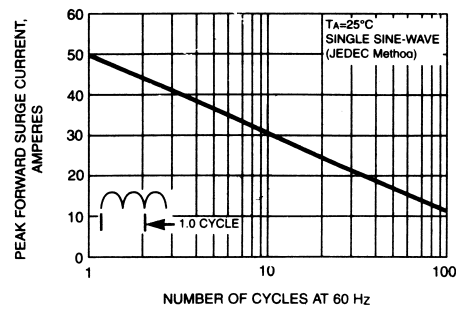


FIG.3-TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

PER LEG

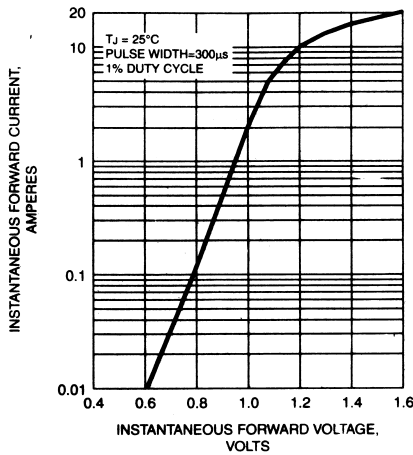


FIG.4-TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

PER LEG

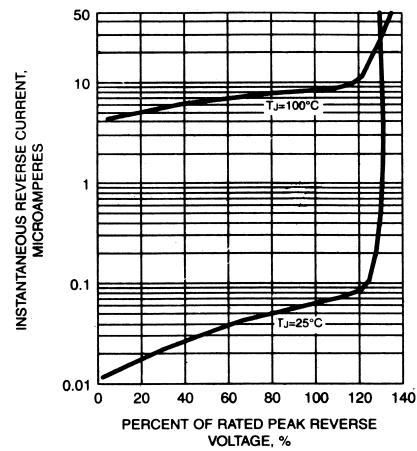


FIG.5-TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE

PER LEG

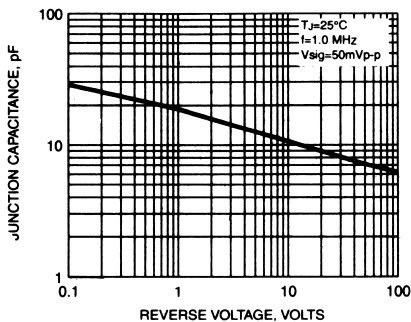


FIG.6-TYPICAL TRANSIENT THERMAL IMPEDANCE
